Conservation Commission Minutes January 26, 2006

The Chairman appointed Mr. Morris to replace Mrs. Linowes for this meeting.

10 Sheffield Street, Lot #11-C-2553

A portion of a proposed two-story, three bay garage in the WWPD Paul Mansback of Neuman & Associates – Presenter

Mr. Mansback explained that since this request was presented back in November of 2004 there have been some changes. The shape of the back of the house has been changed and this reduces the impact from 604 to 513 square feet. The proposed mitigation for the entire site will be detention basins, hay bales, silt fences etc. The garage will impact the WWPD by approximately 12-feet. Mr. Rouillard said that the plan should reflect finished grading. Mr. Mansback will attend the February 9, 2006 meeting and will provide complete plans.

Mr. Mansback spoke briefly about creating a 17,000 square foot (8500 square feet would be in the WWPD) pond on the Sheffield Street property and asked for comments from the Commission. Mr. Rouillard said that soils mapping would need to be submitted. Dr. Finn said that the Commission would need detailed information before commenting and Mr. Morris said that after reviewing the information he would like to schedule a site walk.

Approval of Minutes

Mr. Rouillard motioned and Miss Skinner seconded the motion to approve the January 12, 2006 minutes as written. Passed unanimously 6-0.



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<u> Planning Board Report – Pamela Skinner</u>

Miss Skinner reported that the Planning Board reviewed the NHDOT plans for that portion of the Route 93 reconstruction that includes the relocation of Route 111 from Exit 3 to Wall Street.

Mr. Senibaldi motioned and Mr. Morris seconded the motion to have Attorney Masland come to the Conservation Commission to discuss his qualifications. Passed unanimously 6-0.

Non-Public Minutes

Mr. Senibaldi motioned and Mr. Rouillard seconded the motion to approve the nonpublic minutes of January 12, 2006 as written by Dr. Anderson. Passed unanimously 6-0.
