HIGHWAY SAFETY MEETING

- **N**OVEMBER 21, 2005

On November 21, 2005, the Department Heads discussed the following requests for highway safety improvements and made the following recommendations.

<u>Attendance</u>: David Sullivan, Al Turner, Don Messier, Gerry Lewis, Al Barlow, and Jack McCartney were in attendance. Meeting began at 12:30 pm at the corner of Roulston and Stonehedge Road.

HIGHWAY SAFETY ISSUES:

Roulston Road -

- The following requests were received.
 - Install "No Thru Trucking" sign on Roulston Road.

The Committee discussed a request by the Selectmen to consider installing "No Thru Trucking" signs to address the high amount of construction and other heavy truck traffic using Roulston as a cut through, which has begun to damage the roadway. During the meeting, the Committee observed several commercial truck passing over the roadway.

Chief Lewis moved to recommend that "No Thru Trucking" signs be installed on Roulston Road both at its intersection with Route 28 as well as with Searles Road. Chief Messier seconded. Passed unanimously.
