### WORKSHOP DISCUSSION:

## **Village Center District**

Staff provided a list of key issues for the Board to consider regarding such factors as how detailed should the plan be, what and where should the land use mix be located, should the different mixes be concentrated, how important is it for commercial uses to have visibility from Rt 111 & N. Lowell Rd., where should access points be planned, traffic improvements and existing problems on Rt 111, areas to buffer and location of open spaces, does the Town need a large common or green area, and how to incorporate property owners who are not ready to participate in the reuse of the property.

The Board discussed these points at length and decided to construct an in depth plan showing the location of connector streets, access points, and green spaces. A site walk was planned for 24 Aug at 6:30 PM, with the discussion to continue at the workshop session scheduled for that evening. It was decided to invite both HDC & Conservation to participate in the site walk.

Mr. LoChiatto motioned to adjourn. Ms Skinner seconded. Passed 7-0. Meeting adjourned at 9:30 pm.
