HIGHWAY SAFETY ISSUES

RANGE ROAD/GRIFFIN PARK

The committee discussed the parking issues along Range Road specifically in the area between Griffin Park and Squire Armor Road. Constant complaints is that as motorists exit Griffin Park, their line of site is impeded to the south as vehicles continue to park along the side of the road during multiple events. There was also a concern of a large pot hole that exists as you exit Griffin Park and turn right. It was asked if the State could repair it. After discussion, the committee unanimously supported the Chairman to draft letter to Board of Selectmen requesting that NH DOT place No Parking Signs on Range Road and that they repair the large pot hole that currently exists. Chief Lewis also asked that the committee hold off on issuing the letter so that we could look at all intersecting roads along Range Road for vegetation that may need to be trimmed back to improve upon those line of site issues. The committee agreed.

PLAN REVIEWS

13 & 15 INDIAN ROCK ROAD

The committee reviewed the plans as presented. The committee discussed the lack of secondary access to this project from Route 111 or North Lowell Road for Public Safety reasons. Those departments are addressing that as well. After further review, the committee had no further comments.
